CALNET II Awards

The Department of Technology Services (DTS) is pleased to announce that the four CALNET II Master Service Agreements (MSAs) have been fully executed and signed as of January 30, 2007. (We previously mistakenly announced it as January 31, 2007.) The competitively bid MSAs will provide traditional and new telecommunications services to California government agencies over the next five years with an option for two additional one-year extensions.

The DTS anticipates a 10% overall cost savings over the CALNET I MSA with enhanced Service Level Agreements (SLAs) that will help guarantee service quality. The new MSAs are structured to create continuous downward pressure on pricing with non-exclusivity and Individual Price Reduction (IPR) provisions to help foster a competitive environment throughout the term of each MSA.

CALNET II provides four distinct MSAs to choose from to help meet your telecommunications business needs. The CALNET II MSAs have been awarded as follows:

MSA 1 – Traditional Voice and Data Services (Core Services), **AT&T**

MSA 2 – Long Distance for Voice Services, **AT&T**

MSA 3 – Internet Protocol (IP) Services, **Verizon Business**

MSA 4 – Broadband Fixed Wireless Access (BFWA) Services, **Verizon Business**

We encourage you to review the CALNET II RFP and Model Contract Language posted at www.dts.ca.gov/stnd. See CALNET II. The RFP Sections and Contract Language for each Module (now each MSA), were incorporated into the MSAs and are updated with all the changes that were made during the RFP and award process. Therefore, there is no need to review the RFP Addendums.

Customer Information Forum #2

On March 8, 2007, the DTS will hold the second CALNET II Transition Information Forum at the CalPERS Auditorium, 400 Q Street, Sacramento, CA 95814, from 9:30 AM to 11:30 AM. Audio and Net Conferencing services will be available for Customers who can not attend in person. We encourage you to be thinking about your telecommunications inventory and other transition needs now, and to bring your questions.
