PURPOSE

This chapter provides information about CALNET Long Distance services and Calling Card services.

POLICY

Services that are usage sensitive, such as long distance and calling card, are available through CALNET. Long distance and toll free services can be acquired using either switched or dedicated access, depending on amount of usage, telephone equipment, agency location and budgetary parameters. Agencies that require any of these services may subscribe with the CALNET vendor through their Agency Telecommunications Representative (ATR).

CALNET LONG DISTANCE SERVICE

Long distance service is available for intrastate, interstate and international calling from agency telephones.

CALNET CARDS

CALNET Cards are available to customers to access the network when they are away from the office, whether traveling or telecommuting. The calling cards access CALNET for long distance intrastate, interstate and international calls from any telephone in the United States.
